Sexual Violence 2021 Annual Report for Amherst County Adult Detention Center

Data included in this report is from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021

Inmates confined in ACADC on December 31, 2021 were 369 males and 65 females. During 2021, new admissions to the jail were 833 males and 401 females. The average daily population at ACADC in 2021 was 382 males and 87 females.

Inmate on Inmate Sexual Violence

The categories of inmate-on-inmate sexual violence are reported separately and are:

Non-Consensual Acts:

- Contact of any person without his or her consent, or of a person who is unable to consent or refuse; and
- Contact between the penis and the vagina or the penis and the anus including penetration; or
- Contact between the mouth and the penis, vagina or anus; or
- Penetration of the anal or genital opening of another person by hand, finger or other object.

Abusive Sexual contacts:

- Contact of any person without consent, or of a person who is unable to consent or refuse
And
- Intentional touching, either directly or through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or buttocks of any person, excluding contact incidental to a physical altercation.

The Blue Ridge Regional Jail Authority records all allegations of inmate-on-inmate sexual violence.

There were zero (0) allegations of inmate-on-inmate Non-consensual acts during this period.

There were four (4) allegations of inmate-on-inmate Abusive Sexual Contact during this period. One (1) allegation was determined to be unfounded, meaning it was thoroughly and objectively investigated and was determined to have not occurred. Three (3) allegations were determined to be unsubstantiated, which means these incidents were thoroughly and objectively investigated, and there was insufficient evidence to make a final determination as to whether the events had occurred.

Staff Sexual Misconduct and Harassment

Staff sexual misconduct and harassment includes any behavior or act of a sexual nature directed toward an inmate by an employee, volunteer, contractor, official visitor, or other agency representative, and includes two categories which are reported separately and defined as follows:

Staff Sexual Misconduct/Consensual or Non-Consensual Acts including:

- Intentional touching of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh or buttocks with the intent to arouse, or gratify sexual desire: or
- Completed, attempted, threatened or requested sexual acts; or
- Occurrences of indecent exposure, invasion of privacy, or staff voyeurism for sexual gratification.

Staff Sexual Harassment includes:

- Repeated verbal statements or comments of a sexual nature to an inmate by an employee, volunteer, contractor, official visitor or other agency representative.
- Demanded references to gender or derogatory comments about body or clothing; or
- Repeated profane or obscene language or gestures.

The Blue Ridge Regional Jail Authority records all allegations of staff sexual misconduct and sexual harassment.

There were three (3) allegations of Staff Sexual Misconduct during this period. All three of these allegations were determined to be unfounded. This means the allegations were investigated thoroughly and objectively and found to not have occurred.

There were zero (0) allegations of Staff Sexual Harassment during this period.

A review was conducted by the PREA incident review committee; assembled to discuss our current PREA procedures, current video monitoring capabilities, available resources, and previous allegations. The committee determined that our current policies and procedures are sufficient in addressing the issue of sexual abuse in our facility.

History:

Between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2020, there were four (4) allegations of inmate-on-inmate non-consensual acts.

Between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2020, there were nine (9) allegations of inmate-on-inmate abusive sexual contact.

Between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2020, there were thirteen (13) allegations of staff sexual misconduct.

Between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2020, there were ten (10) allegations of staff sexual harassment.
